How to make an estimated tax payment via direct payment to the IRS.

Go to IRS.gov/payments

Choose

Pay from Your Bank Account
For individuals only. No registration required. No fees from IRS. Schedule payments up to a year in advance.
Pay Now with Direct Pay
Choose
Make a payment
Pay balance due, estimated tax and other federal income tax.
If you've never filed taxes or it's been over 6 years since you filed, <u>pay another way</u> .
Pay personal taxes

Make the following selections:

Now you will choose a tax return that the IRS has already processed to use a verification of your identity.

You will fill out this next screen using the first person listed on that tax return's information.

You will use the filing status (married filing joint, single, head of household, etc.) and address used on the tax return year you pick.



The information you enter must match the information from your tax return for the tax year you selected above.

Be sure to <u>always</u> use the name and social security number for the person who will be listed <u>first</u> on the tax return you are paying the estimate for. This is very, very important.

Filling out the rest of the information is self-explanatory.

*** IMPORTANT***

Print or save a screen shot of the confirmation once you are finished. It is the only way for the IRS to track the payment should it end up in the wrong place.
